Our CCA class had a Cereal Creation Contest. The students were very creative and had a great time using their imaginations.

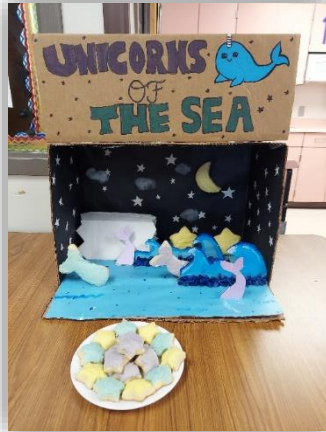
